Each association meeting has a captivating speaker. In 2023 we heard from me (Florida Trail), Scott Grant (Palm Valley history), Gail Cooper (fightthepud.com) and Commissioner Krista Joseph (SJC Update).

Starting the year will be Roderick Potter (Code Enforcement) and we await responses from DOT, Fish & Wildlife, native plants, growth management, home improvement and more.

In 2022 a park improvement committee that included: Eileen, Mark, Karen, Cathy, Chris, Gregg, Mark, Kevin, Rob, Beth, Jim and Jennifer was formed. After surveying the community, presenting a proposal to county leadership and waiting nearly one year, our efforts resulted in \$200,000 allocated for park improvement planning & design. Public comment on the design will be sought this spring. In September the commissioners will vote on the FY 2025 budget, we hope for \$2 million for our park!

In November commissioners approved the Ponte Vedra Inn & Club Planned Unit Development (PUD). We will likely notice an increase in A1A traffic and noise and dirt from tennis court construction on the Gate tract. The chain link fence was finally replaced, and a number of trees were planted. No word on any future / rumored development on the parcel. Stay tuned.
