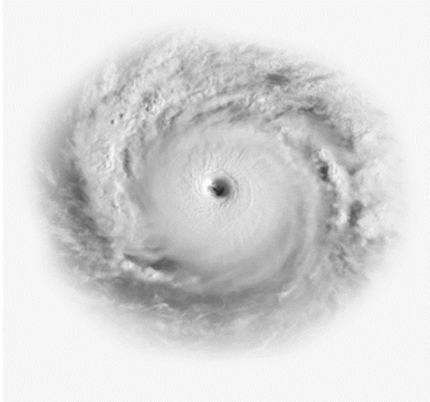


Hurricane Checklist
